**Legal Services to the Elderly** offers free legal assistance in general civil matters.

**You are eligible for the Program if:**

- ♦ You are a Baltimore city resident.
- ♦ You are age 60 or over.

The Program provides:

- ♦ Representation, information, and advice in general civil matters.
- ♦ Education and outreach programs to Baltimore City senior citizen centers, nursing homes, and other interested, eligible,

- ♦ If your problem does not require the advice of a lawyer, we may refer you to another agency or provide you with information to assist you in resolving your problem.

**To take advantage of Legal Services to the Elderly:** Clients may be interviewed over the telephone or by appointment. For an office interview, clients must call ahead for an appointment. With your permission, family and concerned others may call on your behalf.

Legal Services to the Elderly can come to you: Our lawyers and staff will visit your senior center, nursing home, or senior organization to speak about legal issues affecting the elderly and to assist with your legal needs. Ask your senior center or nursing home staff to call Legal Services to the Elderly for details.
